Our aim is to ensure that we conduct our business exclusively and without exception from ethically unobjectionable aspects.

EU Regulation (EU) 2017/821 came into force on 8 June 2017. From 1 January 2021, it imposes supply chain due diligence obligations on Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas. They must identify risks in their supply chains and take appropriate measures to minimize them.

In this context, we hereby announce and confirm that IMR Metal Powder Technologies GmbH and/or its suppliers purchase intermediate products exclusively from smelters/refiners that are actively involved in the EICC/GeSI Conflict-Free Smelter Program (CFSP) and have agreed to conduct an audit in accordance with EICC/GeSI CFSP (Category A Members Progressing Toward CFSP Validation) and that are listed in either the official CFS list (EICC/GeSI Compliant Conflict-Free Smelter List) or in the official EICC/GeSI list (Category A Members Progressing Toward CFSP Validation List). They can be viewed via the website of the Conflict Free Sourcing Initiative (CFSI) (www.conflictreesourcing.org).

In addition, IMR Metal Powder Technologies GmbH is a member of the RTS – Responsible Tin Supply Group – an organization of the ITRI (International Tin Association) and therefore actively involved in ongoing activities to maintain the minimum standards prescribed by the OECD.
